

SUPPLEMENTARY ACCESS ANNOUNCEMENT FOR LOWER NAMOI RIVER

(Gunidgera Weir to Bugilbone)

08 January 2010

- A Class supplementary water access licenses may extract water up to their pumping capacity for **13 days**. This is an increase of three days.
- B Class supplementary water access licenses may extract water up to **100%** of their supplementary entitlement over **13 days**.

Customers are reminded that:

- 1) Your supplementary access limit is equal to your supplementary access licence unit shares.
- 2) Your supplementary water access licence must be current and linked to a licensed work located in a section mentioned above.
- 3) Your supplementary water account balance must be in credit.
- 4) Your extractions must not exceed your supplementary water account balance or the announcement quota.
- 5) Over pumping will result in the usage being debited to other accounts.
- 6) Customers must provide meter readings at the start and end of pumping, failure to supply meter readings will result in usage being debited against regulated water supply access licences.
